Beginning in 2009, the Foundation will award at least one scholarship or fellowship to commemorate Knight of Labor Ugo Foscolo, the former chairman of Banco di Roma, for whom the Foundation is named.

Knight of Labor Ugo Foscolo served conscientiously as the chairman of Banco di Roma, the company to which he almost entirely devoted his life, during the last years of his career.

Ugo Foscolo was an exceptional person who demonstrated the highest personal standards of integrity and hard work, as well as a commitment to talented young leaders of the future. After his death in 1966, it was his wife's wish to commemorate him by establishing the Ugo Foscolo Foundation, which works to support the studies of the best students through grants and scholarships.

It is only appropriate that the highest standards must be met for any prize in his name. The Ugo Foscolo scholarships and fellowships are awarded to top-ranking candidates in support of advanced training for students and researchers of all nationalities, who have graduated from a European university with a specialization in the fields of economics or finance.
